

California Prop 65

California's Proposition 65, formally named the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 was originally intended to protect drinking water from contamination. Now, Proposition 65 is updated annually and has expanded to cover nearly 900 chemicals found in consumer products. These chemicals are "known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm". Proposition 65 requires warnings on products that contain any of the listed chemicals or ingredients. Formaldehyde, for example, is often found in some coatings. Most wood furniture contains some level of formaldehyde. These warnings are only required on products shipping into California but we have chosen to place them on all products as they are produced. Null Furniture ships products all over the United States. Ideally we would have placed the warnings only on our furniture being shipped to California but at the time of production, we rarely know where each item will ship.
